## SULA 12

SULA 12 (Semantics of Under-represented Languages of the Americas) will take place at the University of Ottawa from October 13th to 16th, 2022. SULA is a **biannual linguistics conference** whose goals are to strengthen the connection between **semantic fieldwork and formal semantic theory** and to foster the study of problems of semantics in languages of the Americas that had not received much attention in the early development of theoretical semantics (these include Amerindian languages, sign languages, and creoles, but also nonstandard varieties of national languages, among others).

This year's edition of **SULA is held concurrently** with a workshop on **Lexicography in Indigenous Languages of the Americas**, aimed primarily at native-speaker lexicographers, as well as at professional linguists engaged in collaborative research. Details about the LILA workshop will be announced in April.

### Call for abstracts

**Abstracts are due on May 15, 2022** via <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=sula12>

Abstracts should be uploaded for evaluation in a single anonymous PDF file with at most 1 page of text (with an additional page for data and references). The PDF file must contain the title of the talk, and be written single-spaced with 2.5 cm margins and 12 point font. Abstracts may be submitted for evaluation in English, Spanish, Portuguese or French. Talks and posters may in addition be delivered in any indigenous language of the Americas.

SULA 12 is planned to be held **in person**, contingent on the sanitary situation and any restrictions on gathering or movement. All talks will be **live-streamed**, and we plan to be flexible in terms of accommodating remote presentations where needed.
